

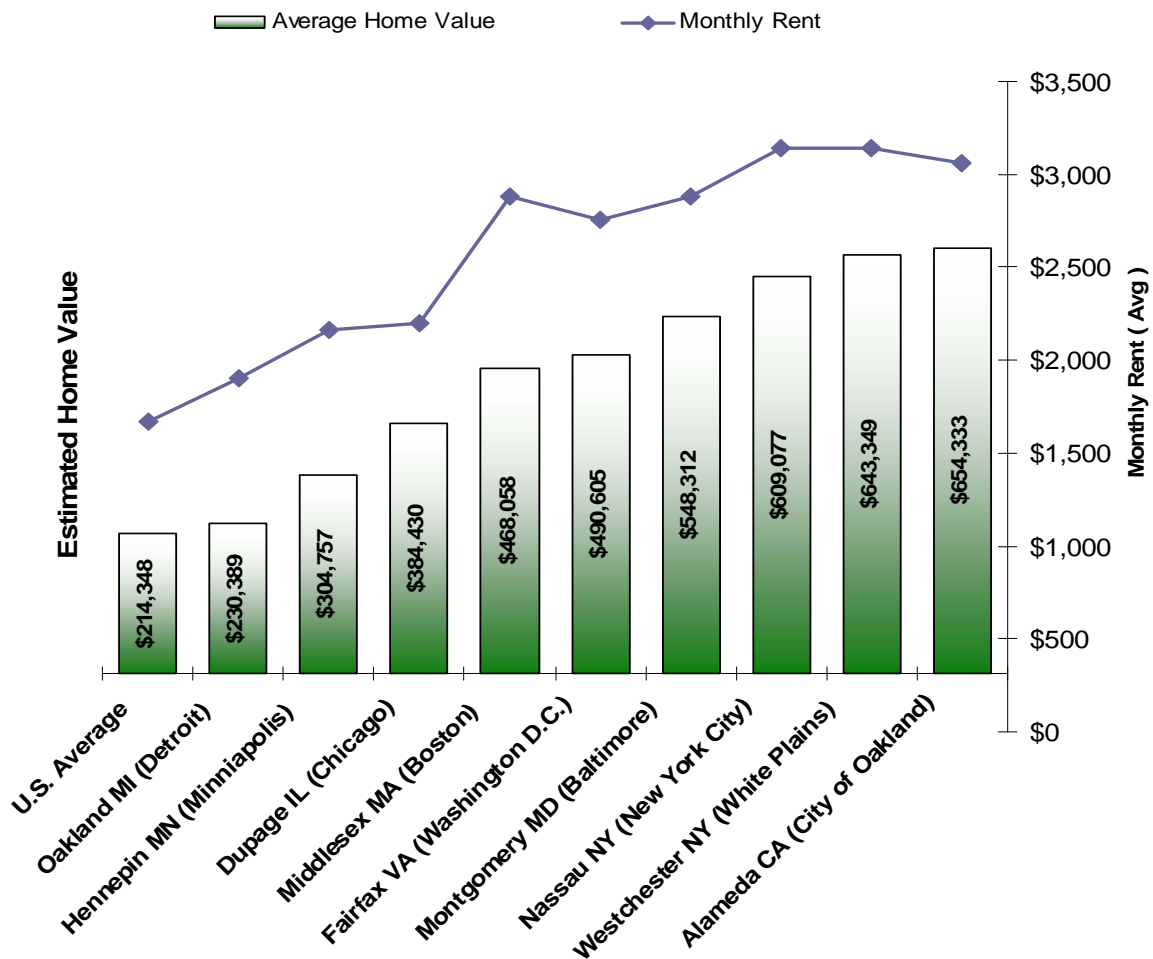
# HOUSING COMPARISON

## Oakland County vs. National Peers



- ◆ There are over a half million housing units in Oakland County encompassing the full spectrum of living styles from single-family residences, to town homes, to apartments and lofts, to modular-style homes.
- ◆ Oakland County's home ownership rate (76.5%) is higher than both the state of Michigan (75.9%) and the U.S. average (67.8%).
- ◆ Currently, the cost of living index for the Oakland County region (Detroit - Ann Arbor - Flint) falls 5% below the national average.
