Programs & Services



- ◆ Oakland County residential electricity is provided exclusively by Consumers Power and DTE Energy, although commercial and industrial customers have a choice among twenty-one alternative energy producers for electricity generation. Visit the Michigan Public Service Commission for a list of alternative providers at www.michigan.gov/mpsc

- ◆ DTE Energy also offers a GreenCurrentsSM program, a voluntary program that makes “being green” easy and affordable. The funds contributed to the GreenCurrentsSM program are used to support the generation of electricity from Michigan-based, renewable energy sources.
 - Residential rates are an additional \$2.50 for only the first 100 kWh/month (regular rates thereafter), or 100% of electricity consumption for an additional \$0.02 per kWh.

 - Business rates are an additional \$20.00 for only the first 1000 kWh/month (regular rates thereafter), or 100% of electricity consumption for an additional \$0.02 per kWh.

- ◆ In the fall of 2009, DTE Energy will launch the SolarCurrentsTM pilot program. The program will make energy 50% more affordable for customers for customers who purchase and install a solar photovoltaic system. Qualifying solar projects must be between 1 kW and 20 kW, installed per all applicable local codes and standards, and under a signed parallel operating agreement with Detroit Edison. Program is limited to 1,500 customers.

- ◆ Some outlying communities’ heating fuel needs are met by propane gas providers. If you live in Brandon, Holly, Orion Township, Oxford Township, Milford, Waterford or White Lake and your home or business is not serviced by a natural gas provider, contact one of these service providers for pricing and availability:

Electricity for Residents



◆ Residential Electric Service Rate

POWER SUPPLY CHARGES:

6.486¢ per kWh for the first 17 kWh/day

7.896¢ per kWh for the excess

DELIVERY AND OTHER SURCHARGES:

Distribution charge of 3.547¢ per kWh

Service charge of \$6.00 per month

Renewable Energy Plan Surcharge \$3.00 per month

Other delivery surcharges ranging from 1-3¢ per kWh

- Available to customers desiring service for all residential purposes through one meter to a single or double occupancy dwelling unit including farm dwellings.

◆ Senior Citizen Electric Service Rate

POWER SUPPLY CHARGES:

4.575¢ per kWh for the first 10 kWh/day

13.34¢ per kWh for the excess

DELIVERY CHARGES:

Distribution charge of 0.969¢ per kWh

Service charge of \$6.00 per Month

- Available to customers who are age 62 or older, head of the household and average 665 kilowatt hours or less a month.

◆ Interruptible Space Conditioning Electric Service Rate

POWER SUPPLY CHARGES:

June through October, 5.657¢ per kWh for all kWh

November through May, 3.761¢ per kWh for all kWh

DELIVERY CHARGES:

Distribution charge of 3.823¢ per kWh (year-round)

Service charge of \$1.95 per month (June through October)

- To take advantage of this rate, your central air conditioner or central heat pump must be wired to a separate meter.

Electricity and Natural Gas for Business



◆ **Large General Service Rate**

POWER SUPPLY CHARGES:

- Demand Charge: \$9.00 per kW applied to the Monthly Billing Demand
- Energy Charges: 4.644¢ per kWh for first 200 kWh
3.654¢ per kWh for the excess

DELIVERY CHARGES:

- Distribution demand charge of \$10.68 per kW applied to Monthly Billing Demand
- Service charge of \$13.67 per month
 - Available to customers desiring service for any purpose, except that this rate is not available in conjunction with the General Service Rate.

◆ **General Service Rate**

POWER SUPPLY CHARGES:

- 7.135¢ per kWh for all kWh

DELIVERY CHARGES:

- Distribution charge of 3.168¢ per kWh for all kWh
- Delivery service charge of \$8.78 per month
 - Available to customers desiring service for any purpose, except this rate is not available in conjunction with Large General Service Rate.
 - Service may be available to loads in excess of 1000 kWh where modifications to service facilities are not required to serve the excess load.

- ◆ Oakland County natural gas is provided by Consumers Energy www.consumersenergy.com, except in Milford, and parts of Commerce, Highland and Lyon Townships which are provided by MichCon (a subsidiary of DTE) www.dteenergy.com and a portion of Addison Township which is provided by SEMCO Energy www.semcoenergygas.com.

- ◆ **Residential Rate = \$9.50/month base charge + \$2.0819 distribution charge per Mcf**

- ◆ **General Service Rate:***
 - **GS-1 \$10.50 per meter \$1.9259 per Mcf**
 - **GS-2 \$16.00 per meter \$1.7477 per Mcf**
 - **GS-3 \$482.00 per meter \$0.9066 per Mcf**

* Customers may choose their Service Category, understanding that the break-even point between GS-1 and GS-2 is approximately 383 Mcf per year and the break-even point between GS-2 and GS-3 is approximately 6,702 Mcf per year. After the selection is made it is the customer's responsibility to determine when to switch Service Categories.
